



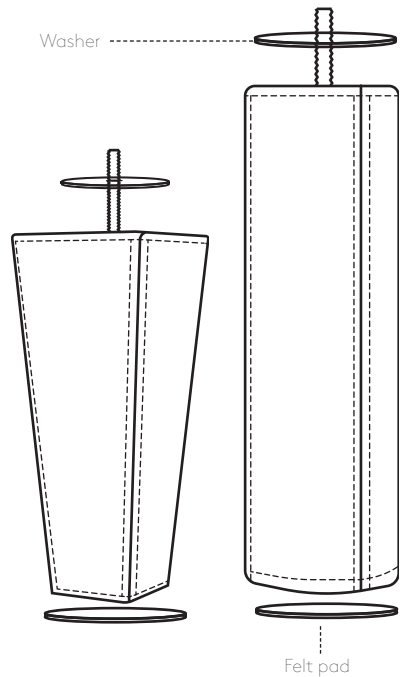
DUX 60

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



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LEG HARDWARE



Please note: Legs are sold in packs of 4 and individually, all legs will be shipped with a wooden spacer. This is not required for the DUX 60 and can be discarded responsibly.

All packs of 4 legs are supplied with a Support Leg. This is only required for beds over 140cm wide.

Thread height 30mm for the Support Legs and 50mm for Main Legs.

If +140cm wide then an extra Support Leg is required.

SUPPORT LEG HARDWARE

×1 Washer ×1 Felt

×1 Center supporting leg

ASSEMBLING LEGS

1. ADD WASHER AND FELT PAD

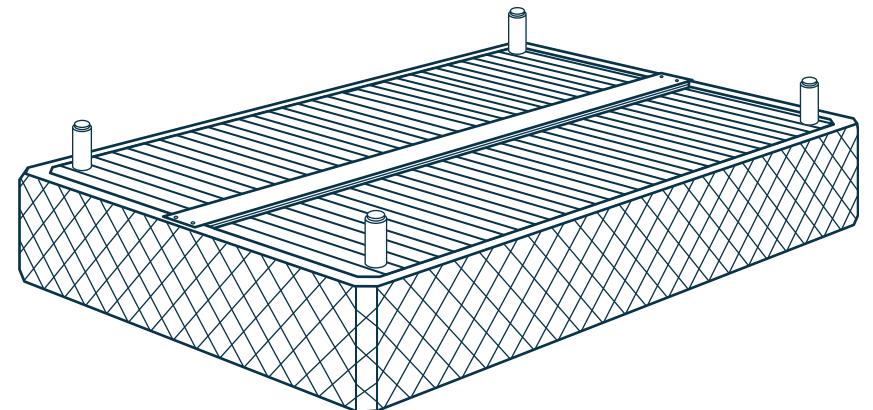
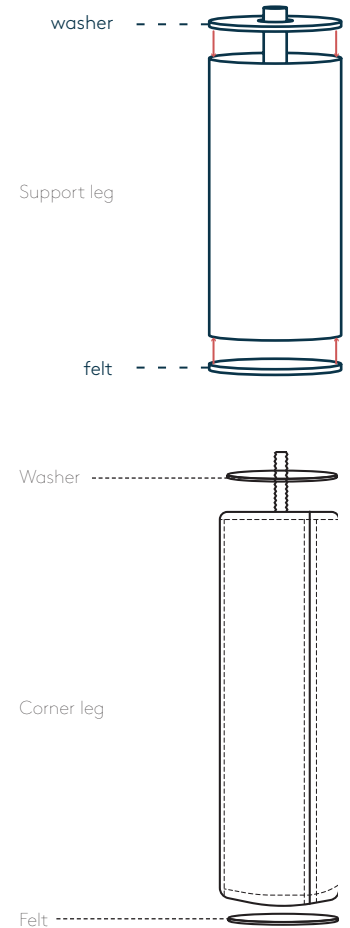
Add the washer to the top of the leg and the felt pad to the bottom.

Make sure the wooden spacer and felt pad is installed on all of the corner legs before positioning.

2. MOUNT THE LEGS

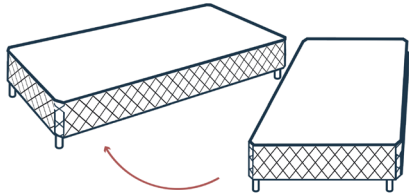
With the bed flipped, mount the legs on the four corners of the frame.

Turn the legs clockwise to tighten.

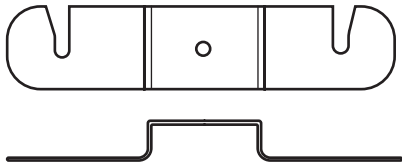


ASSEMBLING A DUAL (SPLIT) MATTRESS BED

For all DUX 60's over 120cm wide



Connecting plate



1. PLACE THE BASES

Place each side of the bed close together.

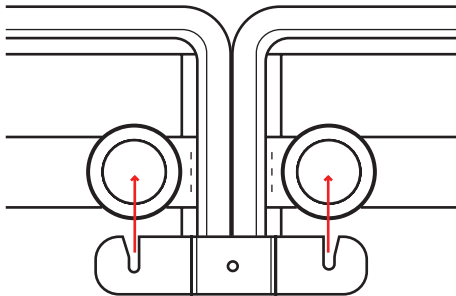
2. CONNECTING PLATES

When connecting 2 bed bases together, you will require 2 Connecting plates. These stop the bases from sliding apart.

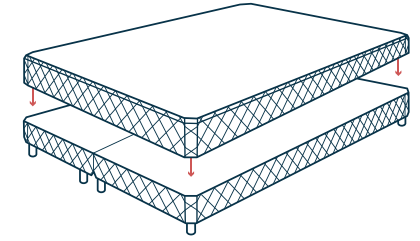
If your bed is 120cm or under please move to step 4.

3. ATTACH CONNECTING PLATES

Slightly unscrew the 2 middle legs a few mm (front and rear) and slide the connecting plate underneath. Tighten the legs again to secure the Connecting plate.

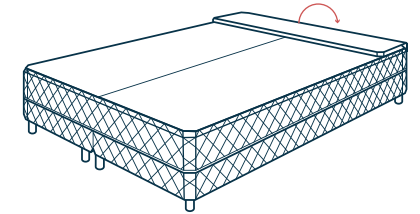


4. ADD THE SPRINGTOP



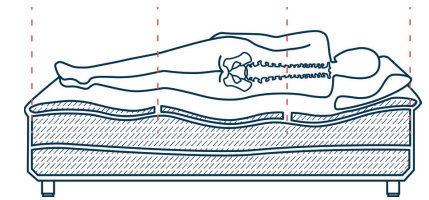
5. OPEN THE BED

Open the bed and fold the top over.



The Pascal System consists of three or six interchangeable spring cassettes of varying densities and tension. Designed to provide three support zones – shoulders, hips, legs – each cassette is selected to match your body size and weight for individually customised comfort.

6. ARRANGE THE CASSETTES

Arrange the cassettes according to your preference and place them in the Pascal Bag on each side of the bed.

Common configurations:

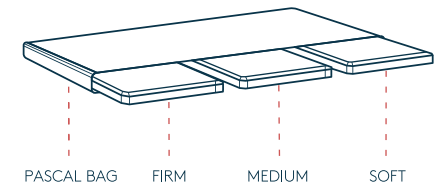
FOR BROADER SHOULDERS

Set Pascal to soft at the head, medium in the middle and firm at the feet.

FOR WIDER HIPS

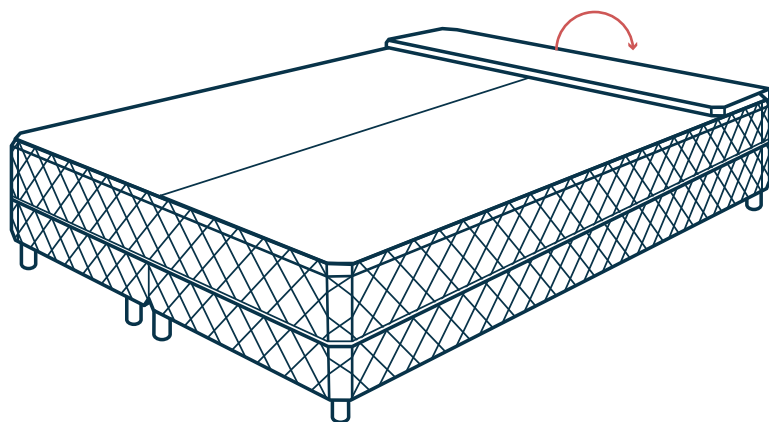
Set Pascal to medium at the head, soft in the middle and firm at the feet.

CONFIGURE PASCAL SYSTEM



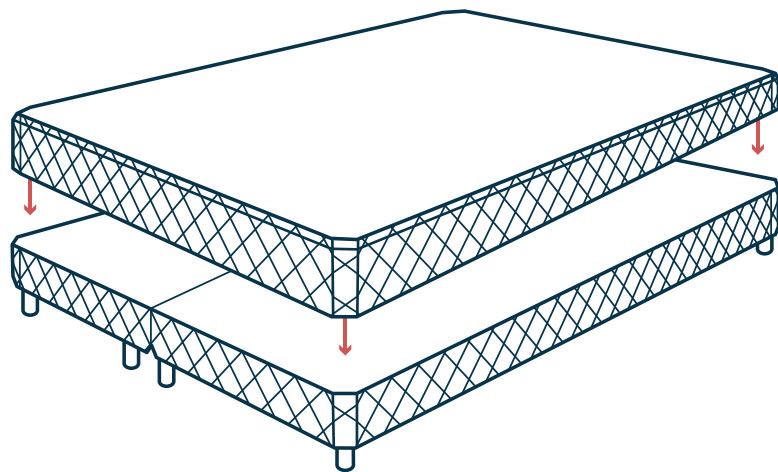
7. FOLD THE TOP BACK OVER

Fold the top back over and zip the bed closed.



8. TOP PAD

Remove the Top Pad from the packaging. Place on top of the bed ensuring the zip is at the head end of the bed.





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
